Greater St. Louis Masters Light Up Oasis Lanes

UNION, MO – November 29, 2011 – If you happened to drop by Oasis Lanes this past Tuesday night ... and you like to watch great bowlers bowl great ... well you had yourself quite a show.

The Greater St. Louis Masters Traveling League made their annual stop in Union and enjoyed quite a post-Thanksgiving, bowling feast. The league is comprised of 8 teams of five bowlers each ... that's 40 total bowlers ... and they averaged 230.25 PER GAME. You read it right, folks, the entire league knocked down 230 pins for every game they bowled. That's an average of over 690 per man! But it wasn't all "fun and games" for everyone. There were actually 15 games under 200 ... that's 15 out of 120. On the other hand, two guys provided a great counterbalance. Bob Marable shot 278, 300, 232 for 810 and Joe Nolan blasted 279, 279, 244 for 802. There was another 300 bowled by Terry Jones ... but he only shot 780!

All in all, there were 24 games over 250 and one team bowled a 3724 series ... 15 games at an average of 248 per game.
